

209-2 BROTHERHOOD FUND DELEGATES

Several times in the past three years Brotherhood Fund Travel has been discussed from various points of view. However, before travel on a Brotherhood Fund grant there are several criteria which must be met.

BF POINT CRITERIA

If your club did not receive the "Alf Reynold" your club's contribution to the BF this year informed about this situation. The minimum contribution required points per member (if the club's members minimum is still 30,000 BFD points). For example, minimum is still 30,000 BFD 2000 cancelled stamps or US \$5.00 per member.

A BF GRANT IS LIMITED TO:

1. International travel costs based on APEX or other.
2. Premium of ordinary travel insurance.

Note: Y's Men International pays for the cost Y is the responsibility of the BF delegate to take out such in BF delegate

and

3. Other necessary expenses as approved by Brotherhood Fund Expenditure Committee Chairman.

PLANNING OF TRAVEL

Travel will be planned by the Travel Coordinator Delegate Plan.

Note: It is the responsibility of the BF delegate to make arrangements concerning his Passport, Visas, etc. before leaving his home country; Y's Men International will provide official invitation letter requested by the Delegate.

A BF delegate is expected to follow the itinerary as presented by the Travel Coordinators, and must be willing to travel for at least the times and as indicated in the BF Delegate Plan.

APPLICATION FOR A BROTHERHOOD FUND TRIP

Those wishing to apply for a Brotherhood Fund trip should complete an Application Form (BF 2) (See sample in Appendix). A copy should be filed with the Regional Director, who will make a recommendation to the Area President, who will make a recommendation to the Brotherhood Fund Expenditure Committee; the second copy should be filed with the Brotherhood Fund Expenditure Committee as indicated on the Form BF 2.
