

## 211-2 SUGGESTED INDUCTION PROCEDURES

### SUGGESTED PROCEDURE FOR NEW MEMBERS

1. TheThe President determines, in accordance wThe President determines, in accordance with the proposed proposed member is ready and willing to proposed member is ready and willing to join the Men's Club.
2. AtAt the meeting at which it is decided to induct the proposed member, the PresidentPresident makes prior arrangements wPresident makes prior arrangements with membersmembers to make appropriate arrangements for induction items e.g. candle stand and candles, lighted Y's Men's emblem, table, suitable room lighting, new members kit, lapel pins (Y's Men's, (...)), etc.
3. TheThe President assigns parts of the induThe President assigns parts of the induction ceremony to presidents (usually). The attached ceremony represents (usually). The attached ceremony ends with the last (#6) being taken by the current club President.
4. TheThe "proposer" and the "inductee" stand facing theThe "proposer" and the "inductee" stand facing the candle stand and the lighted emblem.
5. UpUponUpon commencement of each of the attached parts, the speaker lights the candle.
6. AtAt theAt the specified point in part 6, theAt the specified point in part 6, the President inducts the the Y'sthe Y's Men's lapel pin on the "inductee"the Y's Men's lapel pin on the "inductee" as his part.
7. AtAt the conclusion of the ceremonyAt the conclusion of the ceremony the President welcomes the inductee into the (...) Y's Men's Club with a handshakeinto the (...) Y's Men's Club with a handshake. The induction team as well as the general membership to do the same.
